It is important to choose a job you love. Hence it is important to reflect upon what you like and dislike, so that you can choose the job that will suit you the best.

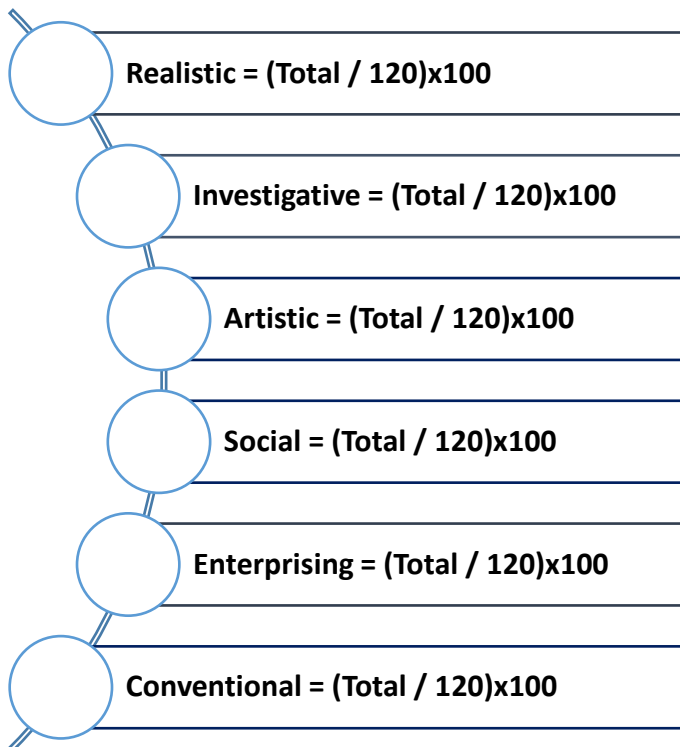
